

CHIPPEWA FALLS and the GREAT LAKES BIOME

A suspected ALS cluster site is Chippewa Falls at the edge of The Great Lakes Biome along the Aboriginal Ley. The Aboriginal Ley has many Native/ Anglo treaty sites along its course. Shelburne Falls, Central NY, and the Black Hills are all Native American sacred sites and where treaty sites. The mountains Grand Teton, Shasta, and Hawaii's Pearl Harbor are also along this ley. Other sites located on this ley are Boston, Murry River Australia, and Durban South Africa.

The Great Lakes Biome, shown above, is a Phi patterned structure. This pentagram is marked by places that define the 'Great Lakes' sense of self. Water symbolizes emotion as it does life. The angle at which the components of water are separated are at an angle close to fifty one degrees. This angle is a sacred canon that generates a phi proportion.
